


GOOD NEWS CLUB


Our Brand New AWANA Commander is:

Church Building Improvements Update:

On a recent Sunday, it was noticeably cooler as we gathered for Meet and Greet in the Fireside Room. It was cooler due to the newly finished ventilation system that became operational the night before. Consisting of several vents installed on the first floor, a large fan upstairs with louvers to the outside, a timer, and thermostat to turn the system on in the middle of the night, it is a system designed and engineered by members of our church. It's purpose, besides cooling the building, is to reduce expensive peak energy usage.

The Reardon family will live in the parsonage for an indefinite period. In preparation for their arrival, both the inside and outside of the parsonage received fresh paint. A new refrigerator was purchased and installed. A new sink and faucet replaced old ones. A washer and dryer stored in the pod went into the laundry room. New windows replaced failed ones. A load of gravel spread on the road will help prevent muddy ruts in the winter. Several large bushes that created a fire hazard next to the parsonage were pulled out. LED lights replaced incandescent bulbs throughout the house. Old carpet was torn up and removed from the outside porch. Trex decking replaced it. Numerous other repairs got the place in livable order.

The final major project that is nearing completion is the bridge refurbishment. We replaced every part of it except for the metal poles that hold it up and the cement foundation that anchors one end. Pressure treated wood beams, and Trex decking will make it last for many years. It was a complex repair due to the height of the bridge. A new metal railing that matches the one on the steps is the final piece of the repairs. When the Reardon's items arrive, the bridge will allow us to carry an estimated 90 boxes of books directly to Parker's office without going up the stairs.
