Questions for Reflection

1. Is there any sense in which you think the characteristics which we are to put on might make you vulnerable and may lead to being taken advantage of? How does your union with Christ and all that’s true of you now, because of Him, give you the security you need to walk these out?
2. Think back to the last time you were wronged by someone. Did you handle that situation in light of the instructions in verse 13? What could you have done differently in order to please the Lord in that situation? How might this help you to walk in Him in the future when wronged?
3. Do you find in your heart any hesitancy to forgive others? If so, meditate on Matthew 18:21---35.
4. How is it that putting on love would bind everything that Paul has mentioned together?
5. What type of witness would a church who walks out these verses have in the community around them? In what ways would this show the world something they may never experience?
